**Stacy Peardot-Goudy** is an agility veteran whose dogs have earned a multitude of titles. She started in agility with her Boxers over 20 years ago. Stacy has trained, shown and titled dogs from 4 different groups including Aussies, Border Collies, Jack Russell Terriers, Boxers, and a German Wirehaired Pointer. Stacy has qualified for the USDAA Grand Prix of Dog Agility the last 14 years in a row. Stacy has been competing internationally since 2002, winning gold in the first ever FCSI dog agility tournament in Russia in March 2002 and came home as individual Gold medalists for the first Maxi dog division, and were a member of the American team who captured gold. With Able, they won the 2006 Canadian Nationals. Stacy has been chosen to coach the IFSC US team in both 2008 and 2010 Stacy is currently competing with Wally, SoBe, Merger and Maze. Many of Stacy's dogs have achieved USDAA Top Ten status in multiple categories for both Tournament Top 10 and Championship Top 10. Stacy is a regular contributor to **Clean Run Magazine**, and is a popular seminar presenter throughout the US, Canada, Bermuda, and Australia. She also conducts agility camps out west. She loves training dogs of all motivation and experience levels and her success with many breeds demonstrates her effectiveness. She believes that agility should be a team sport and fun for the dog at all times, and that the most important aspects of agility training include teaching the fundamentals and being consistent with your handling. Stacy teaches with a positive, upbeat style, encouraging individual participants to give as much to the game as their dogs do.
